CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Works have commenced on site with the removal of the old site hoarding and replaced with herras fencing in preparation for the drainage diversion works commencing.

The vibration monitors have been installed in their allocated locations and the noise and dust monitors have been set and baseline levels recorded.

We have carried out CCTV drainage surveys to record the condition of the drain runs to be retained, all of which required some extensive jetting to remove blockages and silt build up all the way down to Du Cane Road which was needed to allow the camera to operate. This jetting should now assist in improving the flow of these drains taking both foul and surface water off the campus.

The Energy Centre emergency stand-by generator has now been removed from site allowing the hoarding to be removed and the ground prepared in readiness to temporarily relocate the storage containers.

On site, we have prepared the ground for the temporary road across site for when the service road drainage is being diverted and we have carried out some trial holes across the site to determine existing foundation conditions.

UPCOMING WORKS

In the next period we will be relocating the CBRE storage containers and moving the Ark Burlington Arcade Academy containers to their new location to allow the site haul road to be established. The drainage diversion works to the service road will also start in earnest.
