CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

This week, Professors Mandy Fisher and Jonathan Weber joined us for a site visit and walkaround. We were delighted to have the opportunity to show them in detail the progress we have made to date and they seemed suitably impressed.

We have started two new operations on site since our last newsletter: the installation of the main staircase has commenced from ground to first floor, and the atrium curtain walling has started from first floor upwards.

Progress from the other trades on site has continued well, including at roof level where the steel frame for the eighth floor mezzanine deck has been constructed, and on the ninth floor level where ASME Engineering are progressing from the southern zone into the middle zone.

Internally, works have been progressing on a floor-by-floor basis. The screeders have now started on the seventh floor

and David Andrews, the dry liners, are installing studwork on the fifth and sixth floors. The partitions are being boarded on the fourth floor at high level in advance of Briggs & Forrester's M&E first fix which is now progressing across the first floor through to the fourth floor. David Andrews have returned to the first floor and are boarding at low level now that the electrical conduits have been installed.

Off plot, UKPN have started digging up Scrubs Lane and are laying new ductwork in preparation for pulling new HV cables into the substation later in the year.

UPCOMING WORKS

In the next period, we will continue with the installation of roof level steelwork, perimeter cladding and internal floor plate fitting out. We will also progress with the atrium staircase and curtain walling installation.
